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THE FINE PRINT ENROLLMENT IN AND PAYMENT OF YOUR DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR, CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY.

INCLUDED IN PRICE:

1) Deluxe motor coaches — First Class / Superior Class hotels — guided sightseeing — entrance fees to sites visited — breakfast daily — 2 lunches — 3 dinners

2) Gratuities of **\$220** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Not included in your package are passports, flights, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches and dinners per brochure, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, items of personal nature, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. A second deposit of \$500 per person is required within 14 days of initial registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. **All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment.** Final payment is **due no later than 120-days prior to departure.** Registrations received after 120-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee. Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of 35 passengers to be valid. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: If group size is 34-30, then a small group supplement fee of \$133 will apply; if 29-25, then \$331; if 24-20, then \$723. If the group is less than 20 travelers, then it may be canceled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine Tours and Travel*, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) 90-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$1000 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply.** *imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the pound sterling based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (08/15/23) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. **All payments are required in US Funds.**

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge of \$1235 for the basic itinerary.**

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. **Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to *imagine* no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger.** All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$3951 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. *imagine* is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own

flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORT:

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.** A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 days prior to departure.

VISAS:

Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 121 days prior to departure will be charged a **\$300 non-refundable administrative fee** per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 120-91 days = **\$500**; 90-61 days = **\$1950**; 60-45 days = **75% of total cost**; 44 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.** If *imagine* cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 90-days of departure, as the tour is **officially closed.**

STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY:

imagine and its associated companies agree to provide the itinerary described in this brochure. This represents the entire agreement between the passenger and his agent, the travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. All prices, itineraries and schedules are subject to regulations and changes by acts of government, international agreement, and airline tariff adjustments, rules, and regulations. *imagine* reserves the right to refuse or revoke travel to anyone who is, in the sole judgment of *imagine*, incapable of group travel. Except for the willful negligence of its direct employees, the tour operator assumes no liability or responsibility for any injuries, inconveniences, illness, irregularity, or incidental damages caused by circumstances beyond the control of the tour operator or by any person or reason whatsoever, including but not limited to events such as strikes, revolts, wars, natural disasters, pandemic, closures of airports or hotel, default or omission of any common or private carrier, or the fault, negligence, or omission of and by any third party providing services or facilities related to or included in this tour or any part thereof, or in arranging for the same, or the acts or omissions of the travel agent or the tour host. The conditions become a binding contract when your enrollment and payment are received and accepted by *imagine*. You understand and freely accept these risks, and you generally and specifically release and hold harmless *imagine* and their officers, agents and employees from any liability and any claims for (i) any physical, mental, emotional or other injuries whatsoever that you may sustain related to this tour; (ii) delays, damages, illness, injuries or death, or for the loss of or damage to property, from any cause (including negligence) and however occurring; and (iii) any accident, illness, injury, damage, sickness, loss of personal property, delay, or other Injury or claim of any kind related to or arising from strikes, armed conflicts, social or labor unrest or strikes/ work stoppages, war or acts of war, terrorism or terrorist acts, acts of God, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws or acts of local or government authorities, criminal acts, weather or climatic conditions, volcanic eruption, earthquake, disruption of advertised schedules, refusal of visas, or any other causes beyond their direct control.

Day 1 – Friday, July 12: Depart U.S.A.
Tour members make their own flights to London. After dinner is served, it’s time to sit back, relax, and enjoy the on-board entertainment to prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime.

Day 2 – Saturday, July 13: Arrive in London
Today we arrive at London Airport, where we meet our guide and driver and have one group transfer to our hotel and check in. This afternoon, we visit the **Churchill War Rooms** which were an underground bunker that protected the British leadership from the German bombing raids during World War II. Today you can navigate the winding corridors of the bunker and discover how life was for Winston Churchill and his staff who lived and worked around the clock under the streets of London. Explore fascinating spaces like the Map Room, which has been left untouched since 1945, and the Cabinet Room. To learn more about the man himself, The Churchill Museum charts the life of three-time British leader through artefacts, his famous wartime speeches and Churchill’s Lifeline, a 15-meter-long interactive table which pulls together all of Churchill’s activities in the context of world events.

- **Pastor Presents: Leadership: The Need of the Hour (Winston Churchill on Leadership)**

This evening we enjoy a welcome dinner at a local pub/restaurant. Overnight is at our hotel in the London area.



Day 3 – Sunday, July 14: London
After breakfast, we visit **Buckingham Palace** (subject to availability). **Buckingham Palace** is the London residence and administrative headquarters of the reigning monarch of the United Kingdom. Located in the City of Westminster, the palace is often at the centre of state occasions and royal hospitality. Next, we visit **Bunhill Fields Burial Ground** where some of the significant figures from the 17th to 19th centuries, including William Blake, Daniel Defoe, John Bunyan and Susannah Wesley.

- **Pastor Presents: How do we have courage for Christ in a secular age? Look at the lives of prominent Nonconformists like John Bunyan, Isaac Watts and John Owen who are buried here.**

Then we make a short stop at **John Wesley’s House**. In the afternoon, we attend Sunday Worship at **Enfield Town Community Church**, before taking part in evening outreach on Turkey Street. Overnight is at our hotel in the London area.



Day 4 – Monday, July 15: London
Following breakfast at our hotel, we enjoy a guided tour of the **Tower of London**. On the banks of the River Thames in the heart of London stands the Tower of London and nearly 1000 years of history and intrigue. The Tower of London has been used at various times as a palace, barracks, military stronghold, zoo and most famously as a prison incarcerating famous names like Sir Walter Raleigh, Anne Boleyn, and Guy Fawkes. Then we enjoy a **Thames River Cruise** from Tower Pier to Westminster Pier. In the afternoon, we have a guided tour of Westminster Abbey. In modern times the marriage of Prince William and Kate Middleton, coronation of Queen Elizabeth II and funerals of the Queen Mother and Princess Diana have etched the Abbey into the common memory of billions around the globe.

- **Pastor Presents: Sacrificing for the Purpose of Change (Examining the life of British Member of Parliament William Wilberforce)**

This evening we attend **evensong at Westminster Abbey** (subject to availability). Overnight is at our hotel in the London area.

Day 5 – Tuesday, July 16: London
This morning we visit the **Metropolitan Tabernacle** (subject to availability). A large independent Reformed Baptist church in the Elephant and Castle neighborhood,

the Metropolitan Tabernacle was once the largest non-conformist church of its day in 1861.
• **Pastor Presents: Prioritizing serving the Poor (Examining the life of Charles Spurgeon)**

Next, we visit the **British Museum**. With around 80,000 objects on display, the **British Museum** really is one of the great museums of the world. Artifacts from the world’s great cultures from pre-history through the Aztecs, Romans, Greek and Egyptian periods include highlights such as the Rosetta Stone, Egyptian mummies, and Parthenon sculptures. Afterwards, we enjoy lunch in a local pub/restaurant (included). This afternoon, we enjoy some free time for shopping around Covent Garden. Overnight is at our hotel in the London area.

Day 6 – Wednesday, July 17: Stonehenge, Bath, London
Today we enjoy a full day excursion to Bath. First, we visit Stonehenge. This Neolithic stone circle of Stonehenge is one of the most famous wonders of the world. Dating back to approximately 3000 BC, the circle of huge upright and horizontal rectangular stones continues to fascinate academics, spiritualists, and visitors. Next, we enjoy a guided tour of the Roman Baths, some of the best-preserved Roman ruins in the world. Built in AD70 over hot springs the Great Bath still receives over one million litres of hot water daily from the 12,000-year-old Kings Spring below. Afterwards, we return to London and enjoy dinner at a local pub/restaurant. Overnight is at our hotel in the London area.



Day 7 – Thursday, July 18: London to Oxford
This morning we enjoy a guided tour of **St. Paul’s Cathedral**, the most recognizable feature of the London skyline. The marble floors, expansive dome murals and Victorian mosaics have provided the backdrop in recent times for the state funerals of Winston Churchill and Margaret Thatcher as well as Jubilee celebrations. We climb into the iconic dome for stunning views across

London, try out the acoustics of the Whispering Gallery and head down to the crypt to see the tombs of heavyweight historical figures like Admiral Lord Nelson and the Duke of Wellington.

- **Pastor Presents: What does a God-sized movement look like and how can we participate in one? Discussing the life of John Wesley.**

Next, we continue to Windsor and enjoy lunch at a local pub/restaurant (included). Then we enjoy a private tour of **Windsor Castle**, which was the late Queen Elizabeth II’s favourite weekend home. Here we can witness the colorful and very ‘British’ spectacle of the guards marching through the streets of Windsor for the Changing the Guard ceremony within **Windsor Castle’s** walls. Afterwards, we continue to our hotel in Oxford and check in. The rest of the day is spent at leisure. Overnight is at our hotel in the Oxford area.

Day 8 – Friday, July 19: Oxford
This morning, we make a stop at the Martyrs Memorial, before making our way to **Christ Church College** (subject to availability). It is indelibly linked to some of the great historical figures in the spheres of religion, philosophy and politics including John Wesley, Robert Peel, William Gladstone and no less than 13 British Prime Ministers. Then we visit the **University Church of St. Mary the Virgin**.

- **Pastor Presents: Leading with Conviction (Examining the life of Thomas Cranmer and the Oxford Martyrs)**

Next, we visit **Magdalen College** (subject to availability).

- **Pastor Presents: Maximizing our giftedness for God’s glory (Examining the life of C.S. Lewis)**

After lunch, we journey to the Cotswolds town of Woodstock and enjoy a tour of **Blenheim Palace**. Home to the 12th Duke of Marlborough and his family and the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, Blenheim Palace is a UNESCO World Heritage Site boasting a long and diverse history. Then we return to Oxford and enjoy a farewell dinner at a local pub/restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in the Oxford area.

Day 9 – Saturday, July 20: Depart Oxford, Arrive in U.S.A.
This morning we depart Oxford and have one group transfer to London Heathrow Airport for our journey home. Travelers make their own flights.
