Itinerary: Date, Sites, Activities and Lodging Israel Only March 19 – 28, 2025

Day 1 ~ Wednesday March 19th – Depart US for flight to Tel Aviv

Day 2 ~ Thursday March 20th – Group arrival in Israel, where you will be met by a representative to assist you through customs. Transfer to your Mediterranean Coast hotel for Dinner and overnight: Ramada Hadera *HB (or, if morning arrival in Israel there will be a few hours sightseeing and then check-in to Tiberias Hotel for dinner and overnight)

Day3 ~ Friday March 21st - Caesarea/Carmel/Druze Village/Megiddo Nazareth/Tiberius

We proceed to Caesarea to visit the Crusader Fortress built upon the ancient city of Caesarea, named after Augustus Caesar, who imposed the tax that brought Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem. Here we will visit a beautiful example of the Roman Amphitheatre, where the group can experience the acoustics of a structure built in the days of Christ. Continue to Mount Carmel where Elijah issued his challenge to the False Prophets. Visit a Druze Village. We proceed to Megiddo, Site of the Armageddon, where 22 layers of civilization have been excavated, down to King Solomon's Stables. Now on to Nazareth, where Jesus spent the silent years of his life. From Nazareth the road winds down to Tiberius and the beautiful Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Caesar Hotel Tiberius, *HB

Day 4 ~ Saturday March 22nd - Boat Ride on Sea of Galilee/Jesus Boat Kibbutz Tour/Golan Heights (Caesarea Philippi/Tel Dan/ Korazin/ Mt of Beatitudes / Capernaum / Tabgha/ Today we rise early and board our boat for a cruise on the Sea of Galilee. We visit the Jesus Boat, then we have a short tour of the kibbutz, exploring this exciting way of life so similar to the earliest Christians. We then take the road through the Golan Heights where we will hear the explanations of the strategic and political significance of this area. On the Golan Heights we will visit Caesarea Phillipi at Banias, which is the Site of the Transfiguration; continue to Tel Dan Nature Reserve, source of the Dan River leading into the Jordan and containing the remains of an ancient city from the period of the First Temple thought to be the center of the Dan tribe; pass Korazin, where there are remains of a 1st century synagogue similar to Capernaum (these last 3 are the places which were cursed and which were indeed totally destroyed in an earthquake in 742 C.E.); return to the Sea of Galilee area where much of the Galilean Ministry took place. Here were the homes of the disciples James, Simon, John and Andrew. Near here Jesus gave the Beatitudes and taught in the synagogue on many occasions and performed many miracles. The group will pray together at the Mt of Beatitudes. We then proceed to visit Tabgha where 5,000 were fed by Jesus who performed the miracle of the multiplication of fish and loaves. Visit Capernaum, **Dinner and overnight:** Caesar Hotel Tiberius *HB

Day 5 ~ Sunday March 23rd — Beit Shean / Jordan Valley / Jericho / Qumran / Massada/ Dead Sea We proceed through the city of Beit Shean - one of the earliest and most important cities in Israel from the time of the Canaanites. It was here the Philistines impaled King Saul's body to the city wall - we view its magnificent excavations. We continue through the Jordan Valley passing by Jericho, visit the first city conquered by the Israelites in the Promised Land. We view the Mount of Temptation and continue through the Plains of Jericho and Arava. Viewing St Jerome's Monastery, Beth Arava and Mt Nebo. Then on to the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth and Qumran, center of the Essenes. Visit the ancient caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Continue south to Ein Fascha, viewing across the saltiest sea in the world the fortress where John the Baptist was beheaded. Via an ancient ferry boat station and the desert where ibex roam at Ein Gedi, David's hideout from Saul, and on to the mighty fortress Massada, last stronghold and stand of the zealots against Rome, on the edge of the barren Negev Desert. Massada is a symbol of courage and perseverance for the Jewish People, where 960 Jewish defenders organized their last resistance to the Roman conquerors and took their own lives rather than surrender into slavery. Continue to Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight Dinner and Overnight: Dan Jerusalem*HB

Day 6 ~ Monday March 24th – Hills of Jerusalem / City of David / House of Caiaphas / Mt Zion / Upper Room / Rabbi's Tunnel/ Bethlehem / Jerusalem We start the day at Mt of Olives for an introduction to Jerusalem. Ascend the mountains of Jerusalem from Scopus to Mt of Olives for an outstanding breathtaking view of the city across the Kidron Valley to the Eastern Gate; see Chapel of Ascension, Pater Noster and Dominus Flevit. Walk down Palm Sunday Road and visit the Garden of Gethsemane, cross Mount Moriah viewing the Tombs of Absalom, Saint James and Zacharia. Travel around the temple pinnacle to the City of David and on to the house of Caiaphas at Saint Peter in Gallicantu. Continue to Mount Zion, the Upper Room and Tomb of King David. Drive to Yad V'shem, the memorial to the Holocaust and 6 million Jews murdered by the Nazis. Continue to the southern suburbs and cross over into Bethlehem in late afternoon. Visit the Church of Nativity, see the Shepherd's Field, we will visit the famous Rabbi's Tunnel, running along the base of the Western Wall (Owing to the enormous demand, and limited access to this fascinating site, our visit may take place at any time of day or night during our stay in Jerusalem). Dinner and overnight: Dan JLM Hotel *HB

Day 7 ~Tuesday March 25th — Yad V'Shem (Holocaust Memorial)/Old City of Jerusalem / Pool of Bethesda / Praetorium / Fortres of Antonia / View of Temple Mount / Western Wall / Via Dolorosa / Jaffa Gate Drive to Yad V'shem, the memorial to the Holocaust and 6 million Jews murdered by the Nazis. Enter the Old City through St Stephen's Gate; Visit the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus cured an invalid man; continue to the Praetorium, site of the public trial of Christ, and his condemnation, and view its ancient remains in the Fortress of Antonia, seat of the Roman Procurator; proceed to the Temple Mount to view the Mosque of Omar and visit the Western Wall, a sacred site for the Jewish People. Continue through the picturesque market streets past the Citadel of David and exit through the Jaffa Gate, passing the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher on the way Dinner and overnight: Dan JLM Hotel *HB

Day 8 ~ Wednesday March 26th – Elah Valley(David and Goliath)/New Jerusalem /Israel Museum/ Scale Model of Biblical Jerusalem / Dead Sea Scrolls/ Cardo Maximo / Southern Steps of Ancient Temple. Start early this morning with a visit to the Elah Valley, and stand in the valley where David stood as he faced Goliath. Pick up a stone, and wonder if this was the same type of stone David picked upContinue in the new part of Jerusalem by visiting the Israel Museum where there is a scale model of the city of Jerusalem from New Testament Times, including the Second Temple. Also at the Museum visit the Dead Sea Scrolls, housed in a specially prepared building. Continue via the Knesset (Israeli Parliament) and downtown Jerusalem, to Old Jerusalem's reconstructed Jewish Quarter. See the Ancient Cardo Maximo and confirmation of historic sites of yesteryear. Visit to the Southern Steps, the archaeological reconstruction of the Temple Steps where Jesus walked so often. Dinner and Overnight: Dan JLM Hotel *HB

Day 9 ~ Thursday March 27th – Shilo/Beith-El/Herodion/Garden Tomb/Old City of Jerusalem. This morning we embark on a tour of ancient Judea, with our first stop at Shiloh, where the Ark of the Covenant rested for 300 years. Passing the village of Beit-El we continue to the palace of Herodion, this beautiful palace which Herod built near Jerusalem – opened to the public only over the last few years after a magnificent excavation. We end our tour of Israel with prayer at the Garden Tomb. On the way back to your hotel for dinner and overnight some of the group may want to be dropped off at the Jaffa Gate of the Old City for some last minute shopping, and maybe dinner (at your own expense) at one of the excellent restaurants in the magnificent Mall just outside the Jaffa Gate. You need to find your own way back to the hotel (light train or taxi)

Day 10 ~ Friday March 28th – Morning departure from Tel Aviv to US or flight to Rome

Day 10 ~ Friday March 28 – Morning departure from Israel, flight to Rome

El Al Airlines ~ Tel Aviv to Rome ~ Included in price if doing full tour or Israel-Rome land only Flight #385 Departing Tel Aviv March 28th at 7:10am Arriving Rome 8:55am

Today you continue your Biblical Journey in Rome. Upon Arrival in Rome, you will head for the heart of the eternal city. Enjoy an orientation walk with your tour director, and lunch in one of the famous squares. Continue to hotel Una Deco Roma HB for Dinner and overnight

Day 11 ~ Saturday March 29 - Vatican Museums & Catacombs

This morning you visit The Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St Peter's Basilica. Almost all Christians martyred in the Circus of Gaius/Nero—the site where St. Peter's Square now stands. The Egyptian obelisk in the center of the square is original to the circus, though it stood in a different spot. Here Peter was crucified, according to tradition, upside down (John 21:18-19). He is most likely buried deep beneath the Basilica in the original burial cave. In the afternoon you continue to the Catacombs. Most famous for the early Christians buried here, the catacombs offer an essential contribution to early Christian art. Early frescoes and sculptures still exist in the catacombs. Most touching are the smaller burial spots carved out for children who had died.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel, Una Deco Roma HB

Day 12 ~ Sunday March 30 - Rome of Apostle Paul Tour

This morning you start your day at the most inspiring place, **Tre Fontane** (Abbey of Three Fountains). Tradition tells us Paul was martyred outside the walls of Rome at a place most people have never heard of—one of the Christian sites not on the tourist maps. Don't confuse Tres Fontane with the famous Trevi Fountain. It's called Tres Fontane ("Three Fountains") because, according to legend, after Paul's head was cut off, it bounced three times, and three fountains sprang up! You gather at the gardens here for your teaching. Next, you see the Church of St Paul outside the walls; many believe Paul is buried here.

Paul went to Rome as a prisoner in chains; Acts 2-28 tells us the story, Arrested in Jerusalem, imprisoned at Caesarea for two years, Paul appealed to Caesar and suffered a shipwreck on his way to Rome as a prisoner. After two years, Paul was released from his imprisonment, after which he traveled and wrote two more epistles before his final Roman imprisonment in Mamertine Prison. You visit **Mamertine** prison today. You continue with a walking tour through **Roman Forum** and towards the Arch of Titus; the Arch's inside relief portrays Roman soldiers carrying off treasures from Jerusalem Temple, destroyed by Titus in 70 AD. Jesus predicted this destruction (MATH 24:1-2) Visit **Colosseum** We continue to Pantheon, Piazza Navona & Trevi Fountain. Dinner and overnight at Hotel, Una Deco Roma HB
