POTTY TRAINING/TRAINED POLICY

- As you are aware, when a child enters our 3-year-old classes he/she must be fully potty-trained (can handle all restroom visits with no assistance). Occasional accidents might occur. However, if we see this as a consistent problem, we will contact you for a solution. We reserve the right to have you take your child out of school for an appropriate amount of time in order for this to work for everyone involved.
- If your child is potty-training while in a 1-year old classroom or a 2-year old classroom, we will assist as needed. Please communicate with your child's teacher how they can best help with this process.

POTTY TRAINING VS POTTY TRAINED:

- We describe a child as *potty-training* if the child needs to be asked whether they need to go to the restroom or if the parent tells the teacher to take the child at certain times or time intervals. The child MUST wear a Velcro-tab type pull-up.
- We describe a child as *potty-trained* if the parent can drop off the child with no special instructions about taking them to the restroom. The potty-trained child would not require any assistance.

Assistance will be provided for all 1-year olds and 2-year olds (training and trained).

3-year olds must handle potty-time alone.
